


Our Purpose: Empowering people to positive ecological impact

Perth NRM is a registered charity with a long tradition in environmental management, and is the Federal Government's preferred supplier for the National Landcare Program's Swan Region NRM Management Unit.

The Coastal and Marine team work closely with community groups, schools and local councils to preserve, protect and enhance the coastline and beaches with educational, planting days, beach cleanups, and coastal restoration activities.

Our work along Perth's coastline aligns with three UN Sustainability Goals - Climate Action, Life Below Water, and Life on Land - with our corporate volunteers contributing to the improvement of natural habitats, and the removal of weed species and marine debris.





We make it fun and easy for your organisation to get involved. Each session typically runs from 9.00am to 12:30pm including a break for morning, tea however this can be tailored to suit your team.

Corporate volunteering sessions are best held in the cooler months between Djeran and Kambarang (April to November). Conservation activities vary depending on the season and needs of each site and can include planting native seedlings; removing invasive weeds; installing fencing and matting; collecting and surveying marine debris; guided interpretive tours, and more. Many hands make for light work!

You will be guided by our experienced and passionate coordinators in:

- Choosing a suitable location, convenient for your team and aligned with current conservation goals and preferred activity
- Engaging local councils for permits and approvals and local environmental community groups
- Providing a warm Acknowledgement of Country and introduction to the location and its cultural and environmental significance to help your staff understand the importance of their work
- Engaging a local Aboriginal elder or traditional custodian to perform a Welcome to Country*
- Ordering a tasty and sustainably-minded morning tea to keep the team energised
- Site risk assessment and safety induction, including instruction on the use of any tools and equipment
- All equipment is provided, such as gloves, tools and sunscreen
- Insurance, permits and approvals

YOUR INVESTMENT
